18 MONTH OLD INFANTS CAN:

- Walk with ease whilst carrying a toy
- Squat down to pick up a toy then stand up and continue walking
- Sit in a variety of positions without using their hands to support themselves
- Climb onto a big chair, turn around and sit on it
- Crawl very efficiently and reciprocally
- Turn the pages of a book easily
- Build a two block tower
- ♦ Say 8-10 words





TWO YEAR OLDS CAN:

- Walk alone
- Pull a toy behind them as they walk
- Begin to run
- Stand on tiptoes
- Kick a ball
- Go up and down stairs holding on
- Scribble spontaneously
- Turn over a container to pour objects out
- Sort by shapes and colour
- Follow simple instructions
- Repeat words heard in conversation

THREE YEAR OLDS CAN:

- Go up and down stairs alternating feet
- Bend over easily without falling
- Make horizontal, vertical and circular strokes with crayon/ pencil
- Build a six block tower
- Screw and unscrew lids, nuts and bolts
- Use 4-5 word sentences
- Complete 2- 3 part commands
- Say their name, age and sex
- Play make believe
- Pedal a tricycle
- Complete 3-4 piece puzzles
- Imitate
- Take turns
